Institutional Distinctiveness

For the purpose of spreading the message of Lord Sri Sathya Sai Baba and for the preservation and promotion of Indian culture, three days residential camp based on Indian culture and spirituality is an annual feature of our college. The camp is completely free of cost. This year also the camp was organised from 14.11.2019 to 16.11.2019.

The objective of the camp is to familiarise the students with Indian culture and spirituality; to inculcate human values and spirituality; to inculcate human values and develop a sense of national pride.

Eminent speakers, from different fields are invited to interact with the students and to tell them about our scriptures and saints like our Bhagwa Sathya Sai Baba.

A fixed schedule is followed in the camp. The day begins at 6 am, with suprabhatam. After that students and teachers go for Nagar Sankirtan followed by Omkaram, Yoga, Jyoti Dhyan etc. By 7.30 am they disburse for bath etc. By 8.30 a.m. breakfast is served. All the participants and teachers assemble for the lectures at 9.30 am. Lunch break is from 1-2 pm. From 2 to 4 pm we again have two speakers interacting with the students. Each day we have about five to six speakers. In the evening session 4 pm to 6 pm we have quiz, skits etc. for the participants. Some of the participants enact short plays conveying some significant message. Participants are encouraged to share this experiences of the camp. Before the valedictory session the participants take a short objective test based on the lectures they have heard. Token prizes are given for the quiz and other competitions held in the camp. A certificate of participation is given to all participants.

In these three days intensive programme, human values and tips to righteous living is instilled in the participants. This is in line with the institutional vision of empowering women with value based education.
