Methodology:

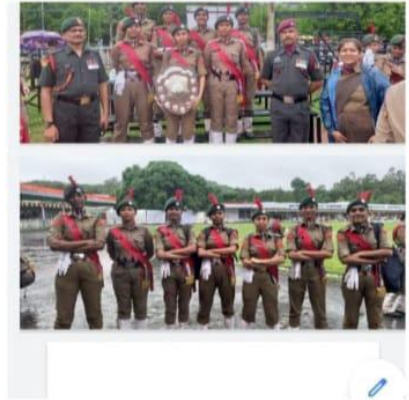

- The teachers or peers also give their feedback and the received data gets forwarded to the authorities for further action.
- The feedback committee collects inputs and suggestions from the students ,teachers alumnae and employer , further action to be taken is discussed with departments and authorities. The decisions taken by the authorities are forwarded for action to be initiated.

- Meetings are held at the department level, college council and Governing Body to discuss the suggestions, trends and feasibility of implementing the suggestions in the feedback.

Analysis Report of the Students' Feedback

Course and Teaching Evaluation:

- The course design aligns with current challenges.
- Most students agreed that the syllabus instills confidence and provides a strong foundation for advanced studies.
- Student evaluations were conducted fairly.
- 74% of students felt that the use of information technology was effective, and paper reuse aligns with green principles.

Feedback on Teaching:

- Teachers are well-versed in their subjects and demonstrate excellent communication skills.
- They are accessible both during college hours and afterward.
- Teachers are highly committed to delivering valuable knowledge.
- Over 66% of students believe teachers can spark interest through various teaching methods.
- Students are also encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities.

Student Support System:

- more than 80% Students are happy with the library, laboratory and infrastructure facilities.
- The advisor-advisee system which provides mentoring is well-regarded.
- Career placement is effective though more campus recruitment drives would be beneficial.
- More than 80% students believe that regular counseling on career paths is provided through expert sessions and workshops.

Basic Facilities:

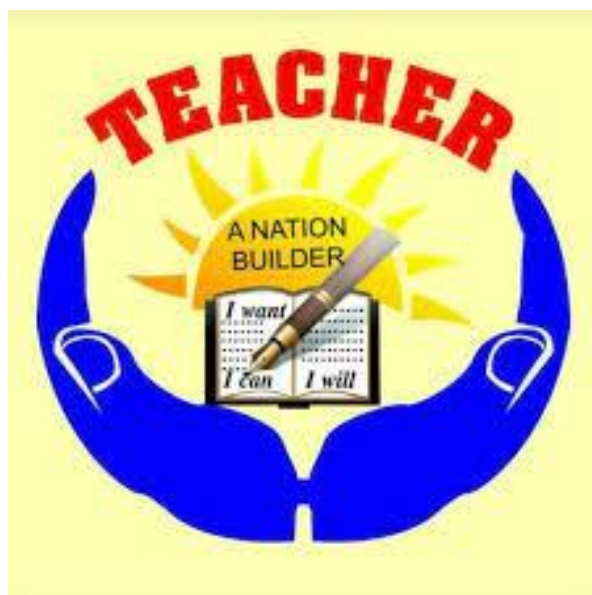
- Clean drinking water, adequate parking, and clean washrooms and classrooms are well-maintained though the canteen could be improved.

Analysis Report of the Teachers' Feedback

The following observations were made

- About 94% of teachers feel that the course structure is comparable to that of other government institutions though some suggested adding progressive, learning-oriented tools.

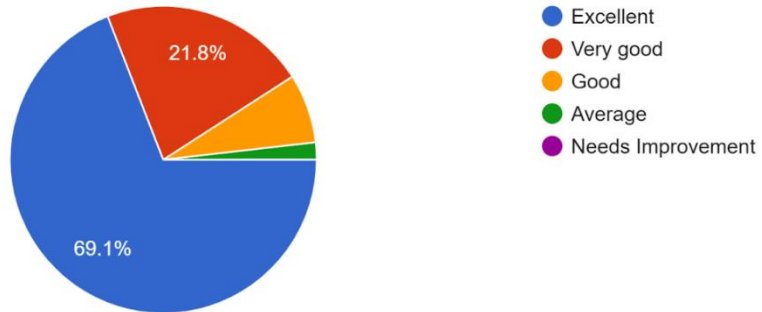

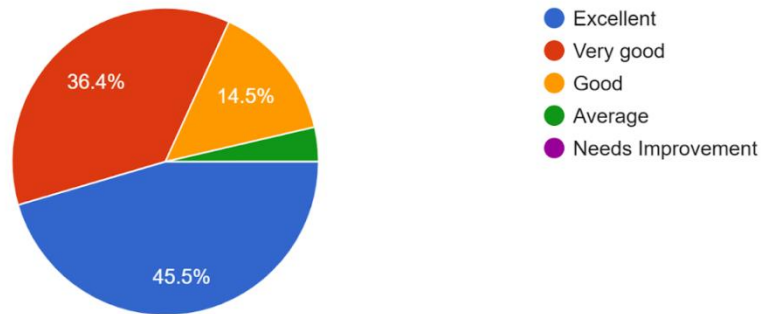
3. Rate the availed career counselling and guidance for Higher Studies from Faculties.

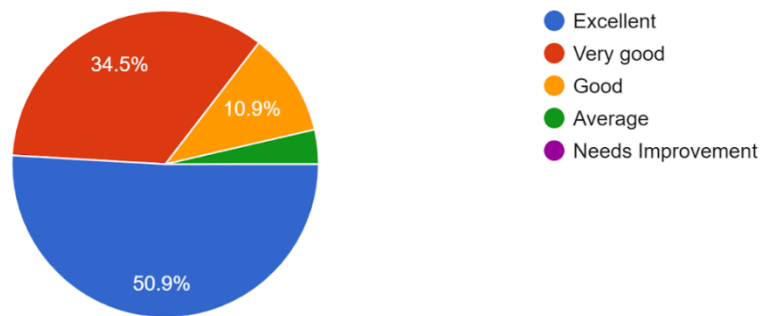
4. How do you feel about handling of Students grievance by Institute?

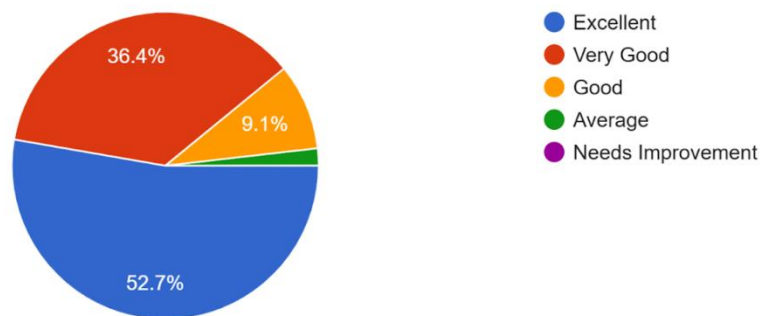
5. How do you rate the adequacy of facilities like Laboratories, Library & Computer Literacy Lab provided by the Institute?

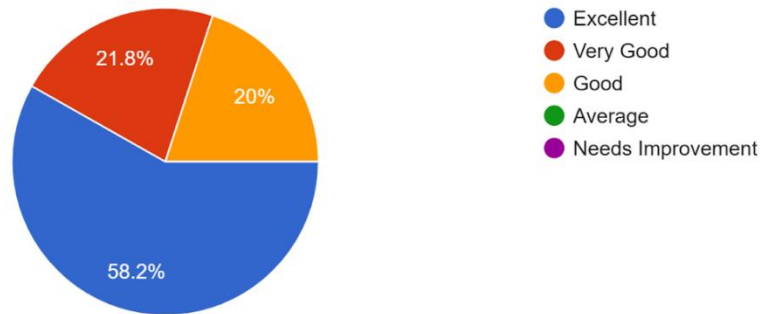
6. How do you rate the Extra Curricular activities conducted in the College?

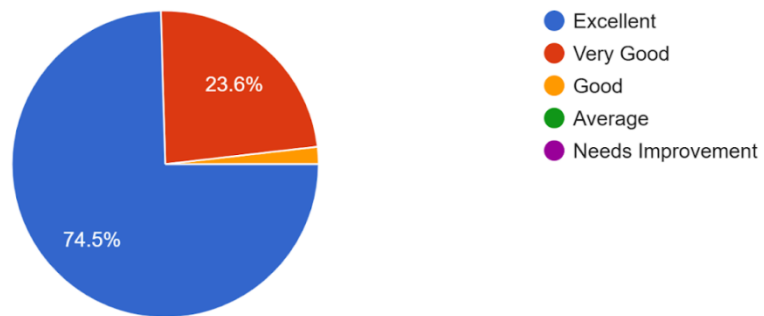
7. How do you rate NSS, NCC, Sports & Self-defense activities conducted in the college?

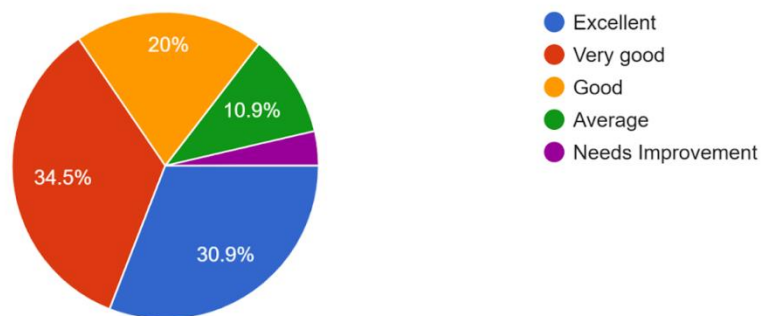
8. How do you feel about the Ethical values and discipline followed have helped in making you a responsible member of society?

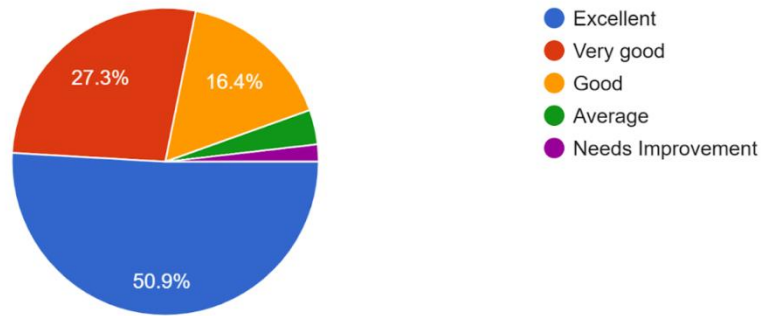


9. How do you rate Hostel facility provided by the college?

Analysis Report of the Alumnae Feedback

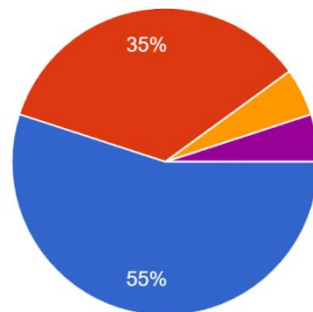

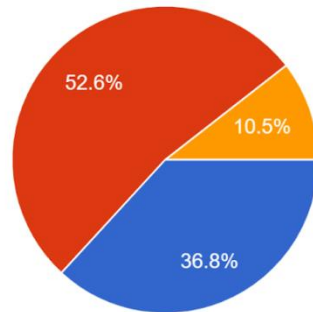

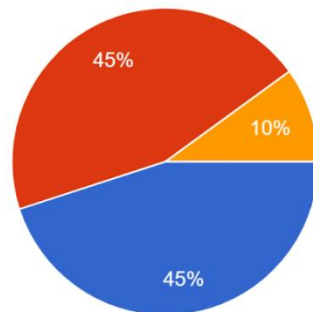

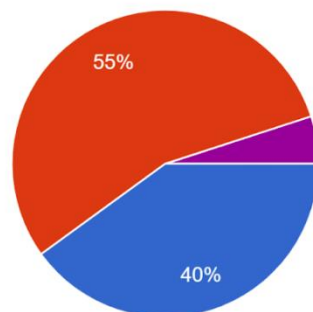

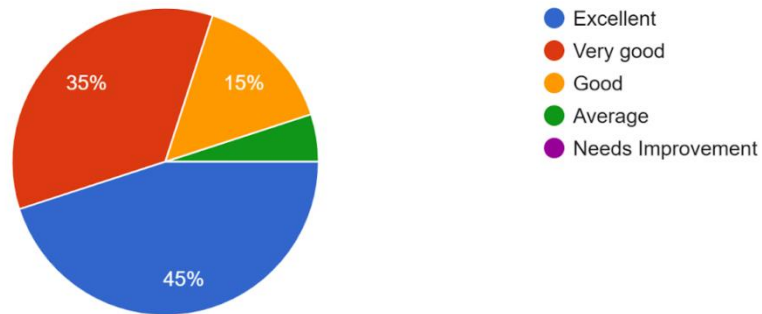

Analysis Report of the Employer's Feedback

- Employers provided positive feedback with 70% rating communication skills of employee as good.
- Teamwork from the institute's work force was highlighted as excellent. Employers appreciated faculty' abilities in planning and organizing events, demonstrating self-motivation and being receptive to new ideas and techniques.
- Overall the response was very positive with students and faculty seen as aligned with organizational goals.

Action Taken:

Teamwork and Collaboration: Recognizing the importance of teamwork more group activities and projects have been incorporated into the curriculum. Team-building projects are organized regularly to strengthen collaboration.

Workshops and real-life event management opportunities have been created for students to practice planning and organizing skills. Students are now encouraged to lead and participate in more events.

To enhance self-motivation and adaptability, the institute has introduced sessions on personal development and soft skills. Motivational talks by industry professionals are also conducted.

Alumni have been invited for mentorship programs providing current students with guidance and exposure to industry insights which further prepares them for their careers.

Recommendation By Feedback Committee

On the basis of the students Feed Back Analysis 2023-2, the following points are reported to the administration:

Continuous Skill Development Programs: Regular workshops in soft skills, leadership, and conflict resolution can improve students' readiness for workplace challenges.

Enhanced Industry Exposure: Increased internships and live projects with companies can provide hands-on experience and align students with industry requirements.

Encouragement of Innovation and Creativity: Incorporate projects that focus on problem-solving, innovation and critical thinking to foster a culture of open-mindedness and creativity among students.

Networking Opportunities: Encourage networking events with industry professionals to help students build connections and learn directly from experts.

These actions and recommendations will ensure students are better prepared for the evolving demands of the workforce.
